forming them of the donation.

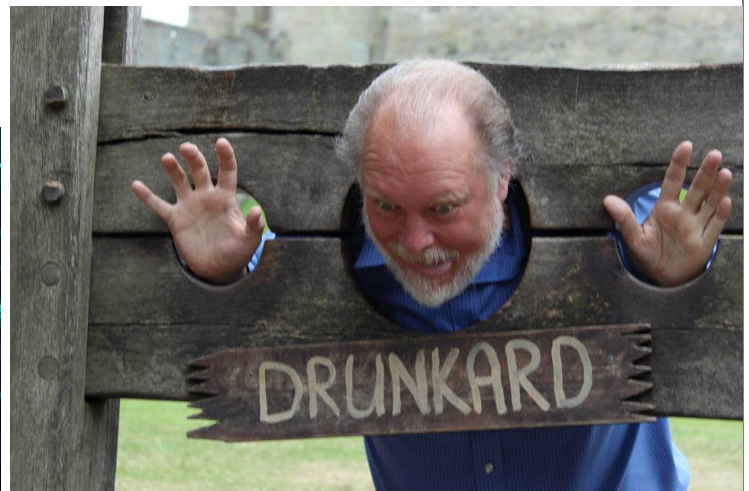
